Life-Group Discussion Questions

2 Timothy 2:8

- Paul so often focuses on future glory. Do you?
- Do you think we focus enough on future glory as the New Testament writers did?
- If not, why do you think that is?
- How can you increase this?

2 Timothy 2:8

- Paul describes the Gospel as 'my Gospel'... Good news that is worth suffering for.
- How does this play out in your life?
- Is it worth suffering for? Why?
- Do you feel you suffer for it? How?

2 Timothy 2:12

- What does it mean to 'reign with Christ'?
- Does it differ from the understanding of 'reigning' on Earth? How?

2 Timothy 2:12-13

- What is the difference between 'disowning' Christ, and being 'faithless'?
- Why do you think they receive different judgments from God?

2 Timothy 2:13

- Intimacy with God means:
 1. recognising God is ultimately in control
 2. choosing to trust that reward is coming
 3. choosing to die now in order to live
- Discuss.

2 Timothy 2:14-23

- Do you have examples of pointless arguments that distort or remove our focus on the Gospel?
- How have you handled these arguments in the past?

2 Timothy 2:20-21

- In what way can you see God pouring treasure into you that would set you apart from 'common use' and worldly focus?
- The biblical word for being 'set apart' is 'holy'. Discuss.
